The York CRC had a distinguished guest visit us on Wednesday 23 January 2019.

Minister Alannah MacTiernan visited the York CRC after unveiling a new plan to open up trainee grant funding to 22 Local Government Authorities that do not currently host CRC's, giving those LGA's the opportunity to train more rural community members with possible 'trade' skills for example: depot staff or parks & gardens staff.

We at the York CRC understand the need for more training in rural communities, and hope that if successful, any LGA's on the list who do apply for these funds, utilise them to the full extent and uphold the training standards that the CRC Network has built.

The York CRC are now hosting our 11th trainee (Kate) and hope to introduce a new trainee as of March 2019. Once funding has been allocated, we will advertise accordingly, and encourage all unemployed, or school leavers who are looking to further their education to apply when the time comes.
