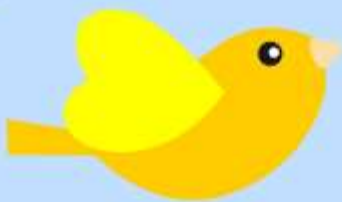

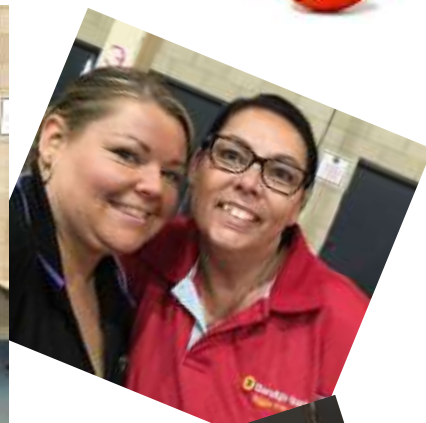

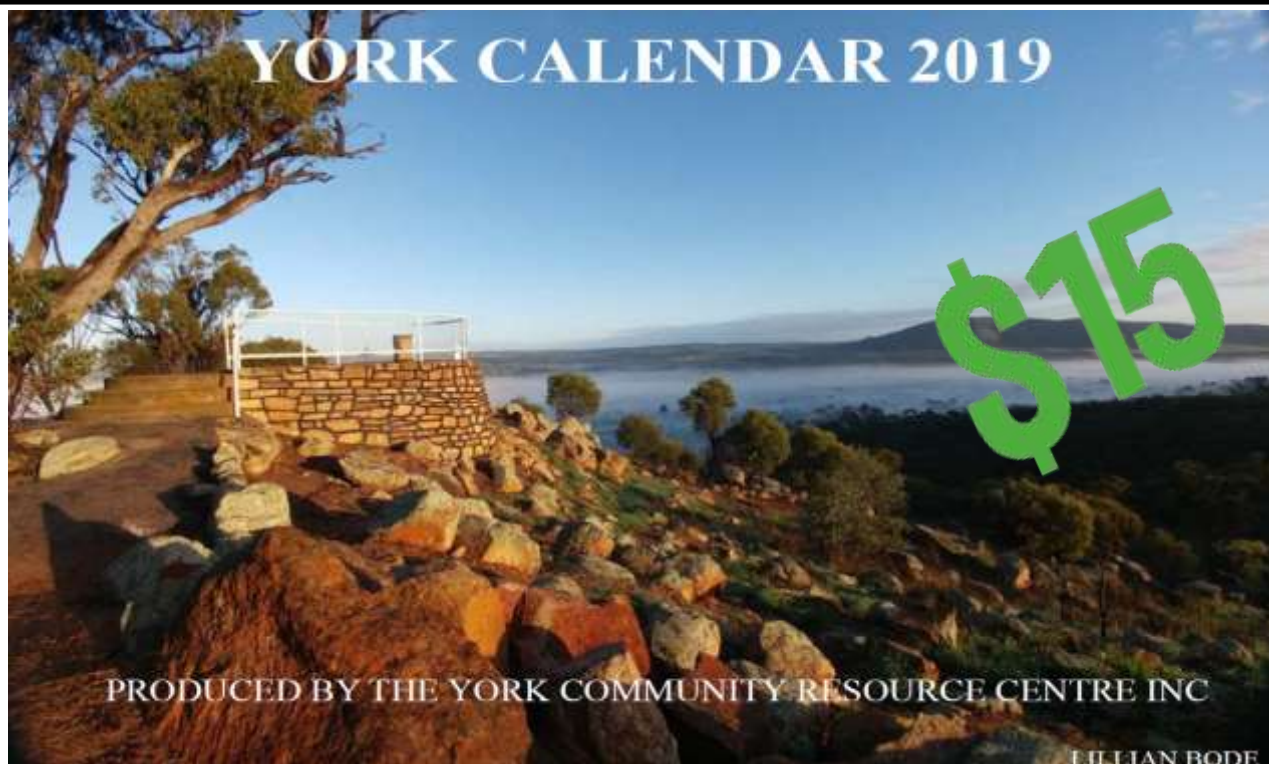


## Uniting Church York

  - ◇ 1 Orange, juiced

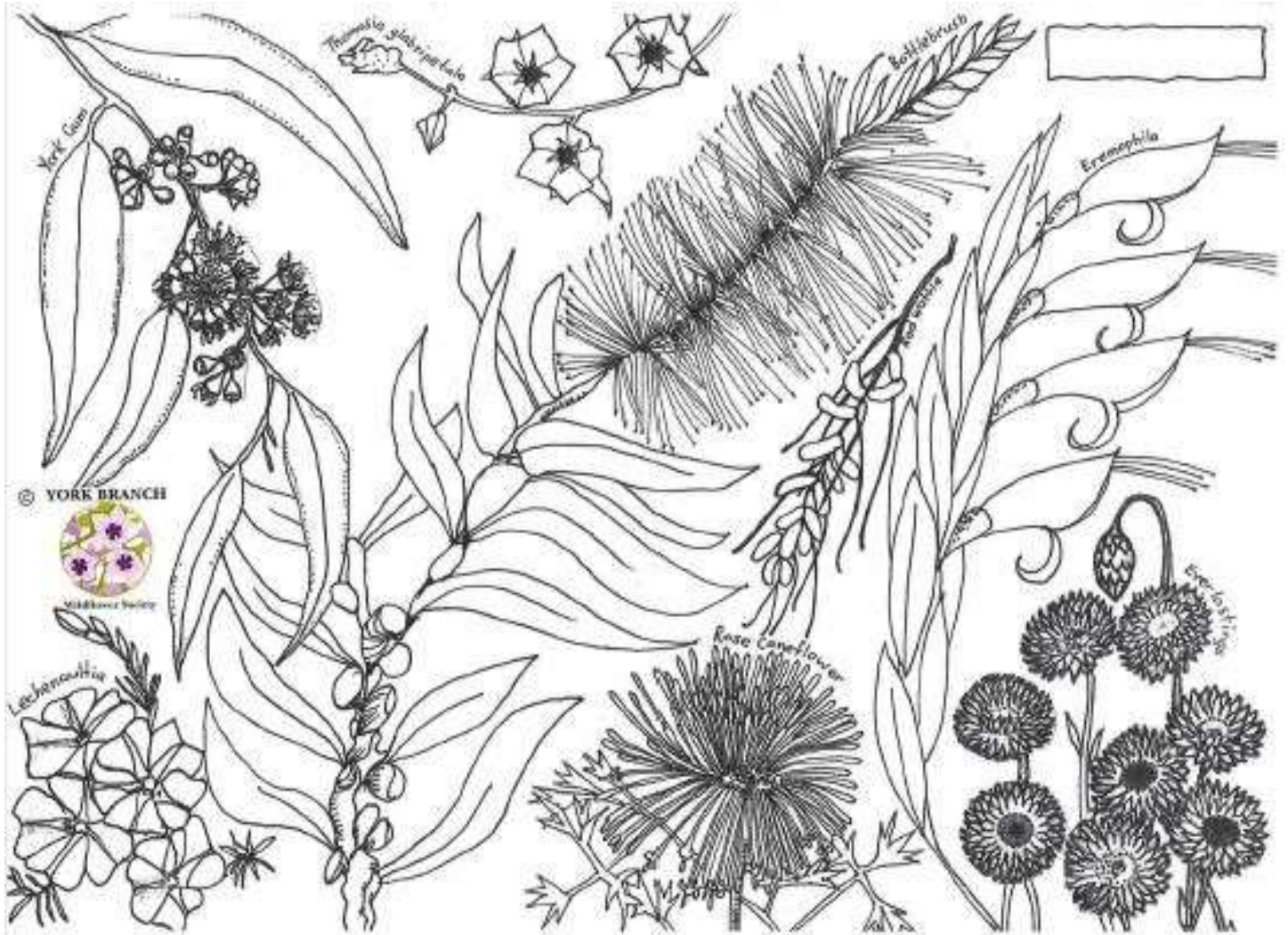
### Directions
